#### Overview of Graduate Funding in Arts & Science



A&S sets policies for graduate funding, including setting a minimum level of financial support for students in the funded cohort



Graduate units in the Faculty of Arts & Science (A&S) guarantee a base funding package to all graduate students in the "funded cohort"



The funded cohort **is defined as**Master's students in Geography programs in their 1<sup>st</sup> year of study

PhD students in years 1-4 of their study

# Overview of Graduate Funding in Arts & Science

 In 2023-24, the Base funding amount in the Department of Geography and Planning is \$20,000 plus tuition and fees.

### Terms & Conditions for Funding

## 01

Students must be **registered** and maintain **good standing** to receive funding. This means they must make satisfactory progress in coursework and other programs requirements.

• If registration changes (e.g., approved leave for part of the year), the funding package will be pro-rated.

02

Students must apply for TA positions and must accept any **TA** and **RA** offers in order to receive the full funding package.

• If TA or RA work is declined by the student, the funding is considered forfeit.

03

Students must apply for and accept any **scholarships** for which they are eligible.

- External awards become a part of, or replace, the student's funding package.
- Examples of major awards are SSHRC, NSERC, OGS and foreign government awards, such as the CSC (China Scholarship)

### Funding Letter



Your funding letter explains how base funding works in the department and at the Faculty of Arts & Science.



It outlines eligibility, terms and conditions.



It confirms funding sources, amounts, and payment schedules (which vary depending on the source).



The letter shows your total funding, including base amount, additional funding on top of the base amount, and your net funding after fees are paid.

## Scholarships & Awards

01

External Scholarships are important sources of financial support

02

Depending on the size, scholarships can partially or fully cover a student's funding package.

03

Scholarships with a value greater than \$10,000 are counted toward the base funding package. Those of lesser value are treated as "top-ups"

04

Students who hold major scholarships (\$10,000+) will not have TA and RA included in their base funding package. Students may still apply for TA positions.

## Scholarships & Awards - Payment

- Payment is processed in ACORN
- Scholarships/awards of \$10,000+ are issued in three equal instalments over the year
- Fall (September)
  - Issued as cash payment to student
- Winter (January)
  - Applied to fees first, with any remaining balance issued to the student
- Summer (May)
  - Applied to fees first, with any remaining balance issued to the student

## Teaching Assistantships (TA)

- TA positions provide the opportunity to develop teaching skills and are an important part of graduate student education.
- Students without scholarships will have a TA component within their base funding package.
- TA positions are assigned at any of the three campuses (UTM, STG, UTSC).
- Students may have more than one TA position.
- Positions can be held in one session (fall or winter) or over both sessions (some hours in the fall, some hours in the winter).
- The maximum amount of TA work counted toward the funding package in 2023-24 is \$7,755.
- This is equivalent to about 160 hours of TA work.



# Teaching Assistantships

- Students must apply to TA positions in order to receive the TA funding portion of their funding package
- If you do not apply for at least 160 hours of TA work, you will miss out on the full funding amount allocated under the TA-ships (\$7,755)

# Teaching Assistantship - Payments

- TA is paid in equal instalments monthly for the duration of the position.
- Payment is made through the payroll system (HRIS) on the 28th of each month (or preceding Friday if the 28th falls on a weekend).
- Payments can be viewed in the Employee Self Service
   (ESS) <a href="https://hrandequity.utoronto.ca/hr-service-centre/">https://hrandequity.utoronto.ca/hr-service-centre/</a>.
- Example payment schedule for a fall position of 160 hours:

Month	Hours	Amount
September	40	\$1938.75
October	40	\$1938.75
November	40	\$1938.75
December	40	\$1938.75
TOTAL	160	\$7,755.00



## Research Assistantship (RA)

- RA positions allow students to work on an externally funded research project. This provides first-hand research experience which is an important part of graduate student education that will be helpful when pursuing careers post-graduation.
- Students without scholarships will have an RA component within their base funding package.
- The RA is paid by the supervisor from grant or other faculty funds.
- Supervisors should discuss the timing of this work and schedule for payments by the end of September.

## Research Assistantship - Payment

- Payment is made through the **payroll system (HRIS)** on the 28th of the month (or preceding Friday if the 28th falls on a weekend).
- There are two types of RA contract:



Casual employee (T4 taxable)

Student and supervisor sign a contract and submit **timesheets** for payment for end of month payment.



Stipend (T4A non-taxable)

Student and supervisor sign a contract which specifies a schedule for **lump sum** payment(s).

## U of T Fellowship (UTF)







UTF is a fellowship provided to ensure all graduate students receive the base funding amount once scholarships, TA and RA are taken into account In other words, this funding bridges the difference between the other sources of funding and the base amount.

UTF can be applied to tuition and fees or paid directly to the student

- Students who do not hold scholarships will have a UTF Tuition Award applied toward their fees in ACORN.
  - Paid in equal instalments in the fall (Sept) and winter (Jan).
  - Students are registered for the summer too, but fees are only charged for fall and winter sessions

#### Instalment **Amount** (usually 1st week) \$6,166.67 September \$6,166.66 January \$6,166.67 May \$18,500.00 **TOTAL**

## UTF – Stipend Award

- Paid directly to the student in equal instalments in September, January and May.
- Amount varies depending on other sources of funding

- Domestic MSc candidate with award <10,000 e.g., Graduate Recruitment Award
- Base Funding \$28,394.00

# Important Payment Information



0

#### Students must be registered to receive payments.

#### **ACORN** payments:

- •An up to date mailing address is required.
- •To receive direct deposit, bank details must be entered in ACORN. If you do not set up bank details in ACORN, a cheque may be mailed (within Canada).
- •May take 3-5 business days for payments to be deposited once the payment is shown in ACORN.

# HRIS/Payroll payments:

•No TA or RA payments are issued until a signed contract is submitted, with the required payroll forms (SIN, void cheque, study permit).

# ACORN and HRIS are not linked

• Banking information in ACORN will not update the information in HRIS (and vice-versa).
